- vi. Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/12/ 2020 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.
- vii. Evidence of Firm's current registration with the Council of Nigerian Mining Engineers and Geoscientists (COMEG);
- viii. Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Council of Nigerian Mining Engineers and Geoscientist or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;
